## Rules of the Competition:

The competition will be split into two categories:

Monochrome Images

Colour Images

Competition entrants should submit their images in JPEG file format which can be sent via email or on CD which can be posted to the Competition Secretary. All images should be given a suitable title .

For assessment and judging, entries will be viewed on a screen using a Digital Projector (much the same as a slide competition).

### Category (A):

Images should be **Monochrome**

Images must be submitted in JPEG file format.

Images can be manipulated or straight, as taken, but must be Black & White with no colour included in any part, with the possible exception of a single overall tone eg Sepia

Images may be from digital camera or from scanned material but must be from original images photographed by the entrant.

Images from external sources are not eligible i.e., Magazines, Book Illustrations etc. Use of copyright free photographs already existing on disc or online, etc are likewise ineligible.

### Category (B):

Images should be in **Colour**

Images must be submitted in JPEG file format.

Images can be manipulated or straight as taken and presented as a colour image.

Images may be from digital camera or from scanned material but must be from original images photographed by the entrant.

Images from external sources are not eligible i.e., Magazines, Book Illustrations etc. Use of copyright free photographs already existing on disc or online, etc are likewise ineligible.

## General:

The projection process will be in the form of a Slide Show compiled from the entrants' submitted images, entrants' images will be resized as necessary to fit the maximum area available for each projected slide. Authors' titles given to each slide will also be added to the projected image.

It is accepted that file sizes will vary dependent on the source from which they are derived. However, files should be sized 1024w x 768h pixels maximum at a resolution of 100dpi. All images must be submitted as JPEG format files.

To aid identification, the file name attributed to each image should be the same as the entrant's intended title for the competition plus the entrant's initials, followed by the rank order number ( 01, 02, 03).

Eg—*BamburghSunrise\_pw\_01.jpg*

All CDs must be clearly marked with the entrant's name and club and be accompanied by a printed title list, indicating intended category and a cheque for the appropriate amount.

Entrants may submit a maximum of three images to each category. The same image may not be entered into both categories.

Assessment and judging will be in the same manner as traditional slide competitions with marks out of 20 being awarded for each image.

In order to give time to compile all entered images into a slide show ready for projection on competition night all entries must reach the **Competition Secretary not later than 21st. April 2008**
